## Sweet somethings

Sweet is a new cupcake shop in the Back Bay, the baby of Courtney Forrester, who couldn't find cupcakes that met her standards, so she decided to create her own source. You'll find the basics — vanilla, chocolate, carrot — turned out stylishly. You'll also find the Big Poppy (left), a lemon-poppy seed cupcake covered with lemony frosting (a portion of the proceeds go to charity), Boston cream pie, and something called "red, white, and you" (vanilla filled with berry jam). Sweet goodies come in regular and miniatures, and you can take them to go or sit a while with a cup of illy coffee. The place has a feel of France in the 1930s.
